### The 'Drubbing' Pan

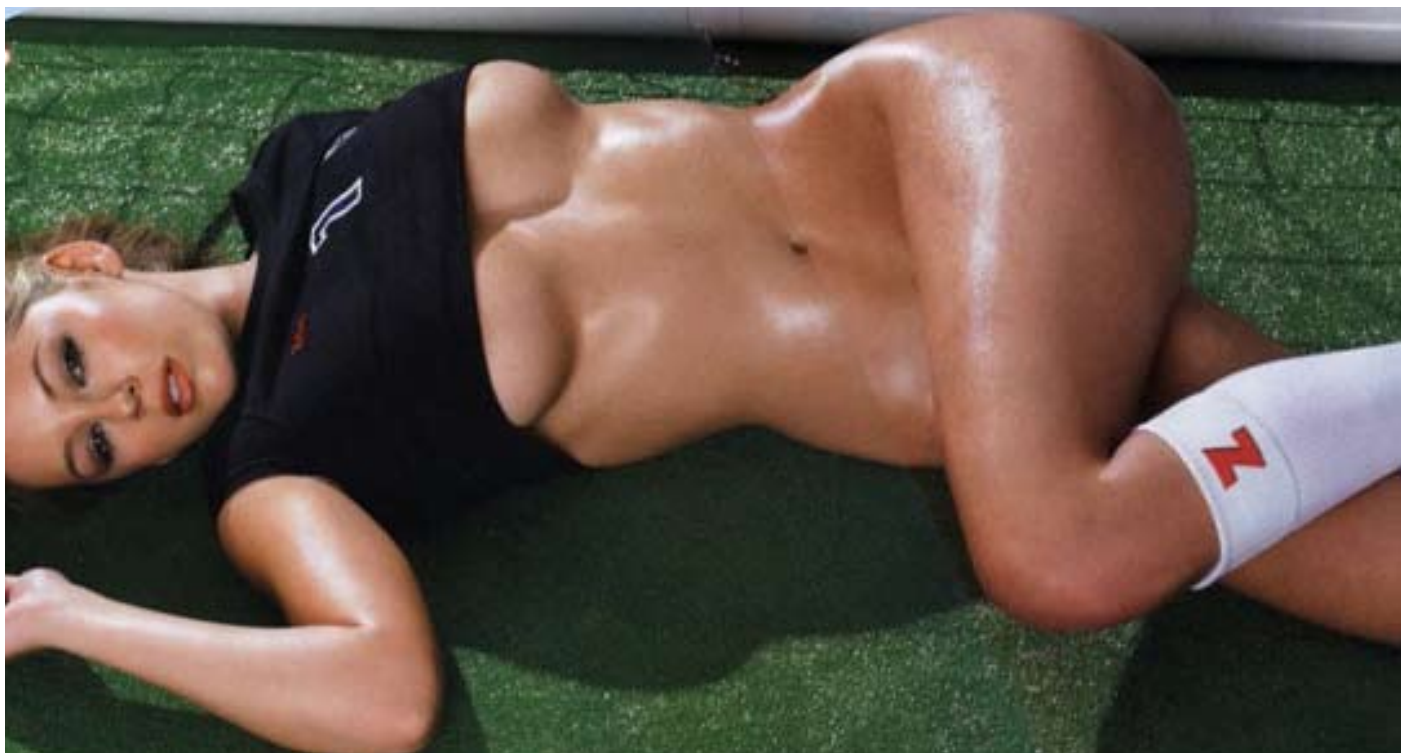
