Ten minutes into the second half and Phil Jorys men took the lead with Ronnie

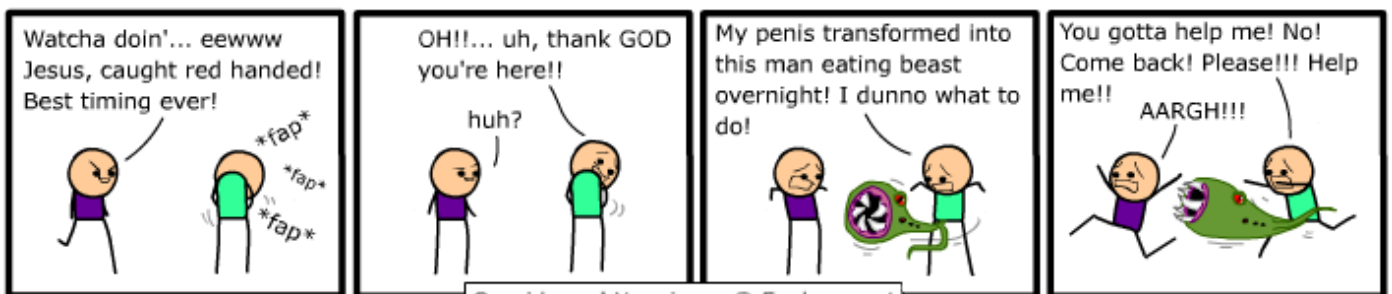
