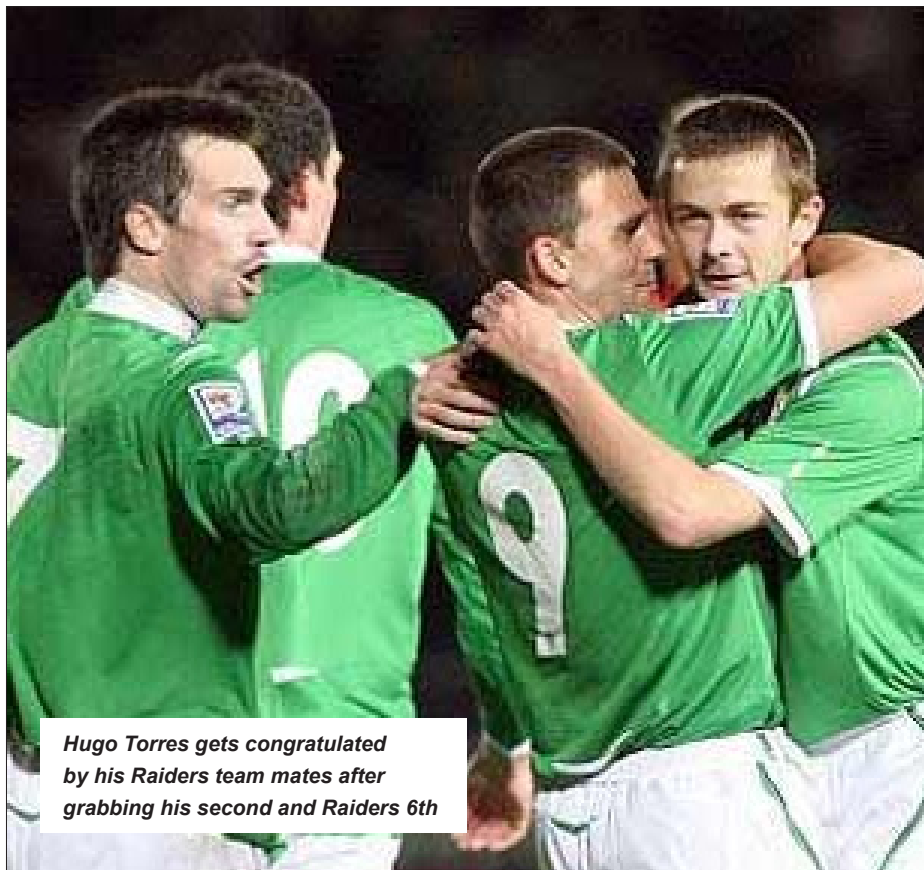

"The game was a close contest, but I was glad to keep the attacking prowess that the Park possess at bay. Our defence was outstanding. Park didn't manage a single attempt on target."

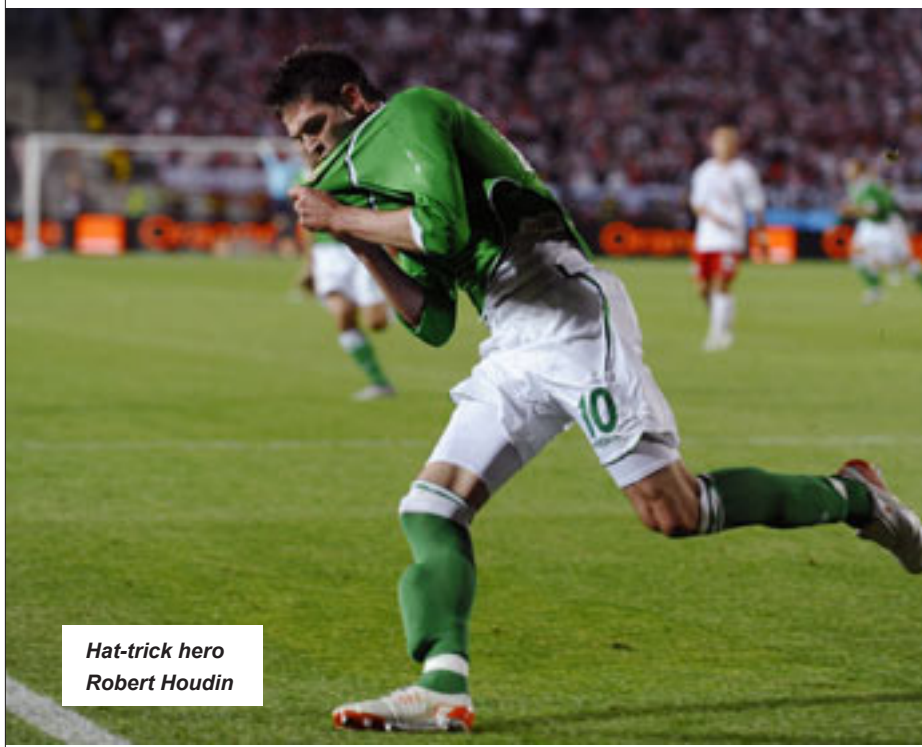
Asked to respond to the suggestion that his opposite number was heard making sexist comments.

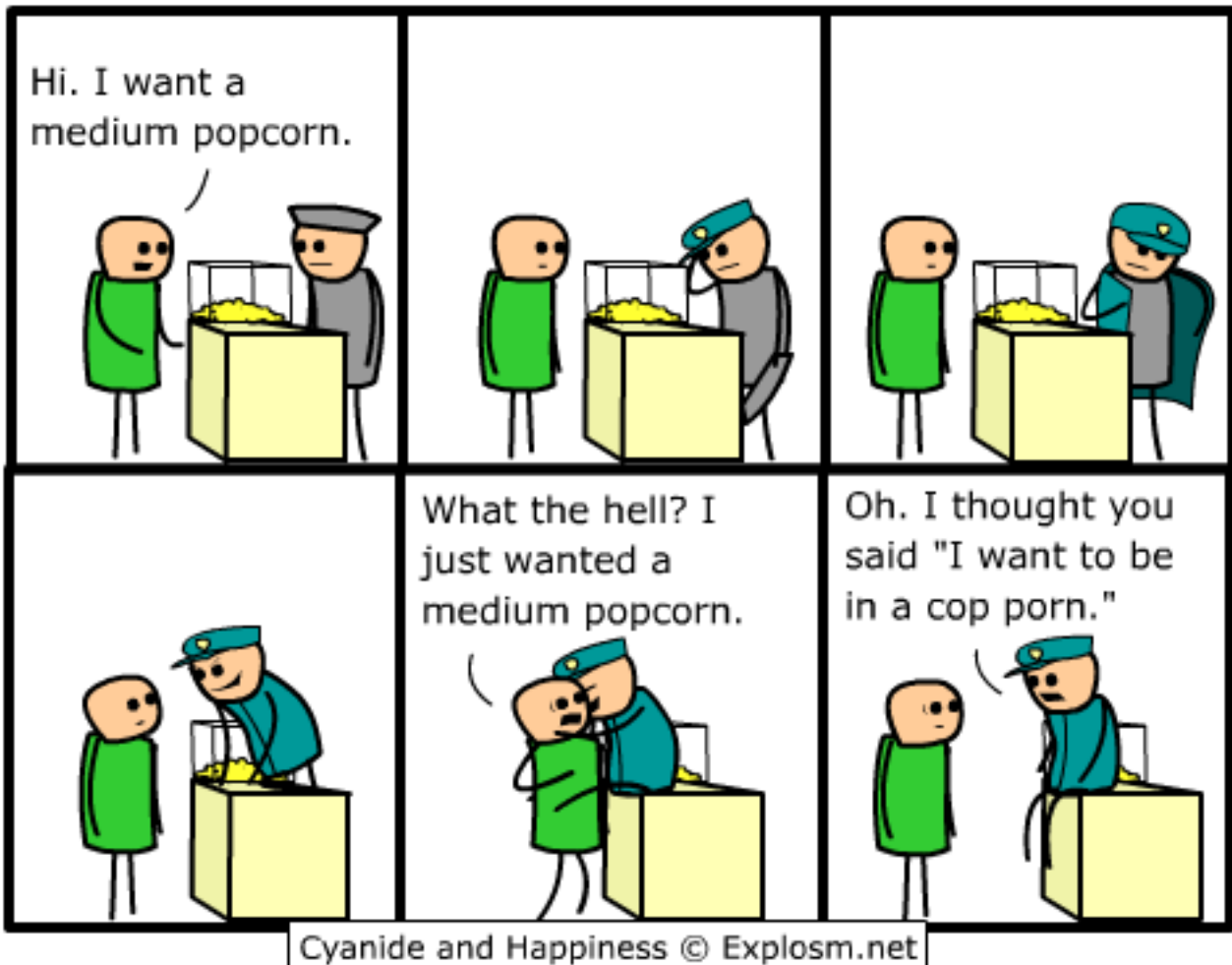
