
DUAO Make It An Amazing 3 In A Row. Plus, All The Rest Of The Ups And Downs From The Final Day Of Season 8

Red Machine FC continued their poor run of form (six games without a win) with a 2-0 defeat against age old


rival Egloshayle Park. Manager Couch looked relieved when the final whistle went.





voted a poor coach by Xpert 11's bent selection committee.




