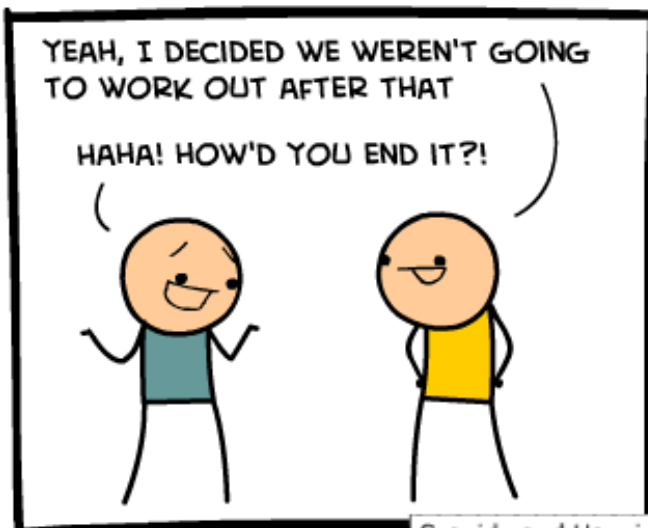
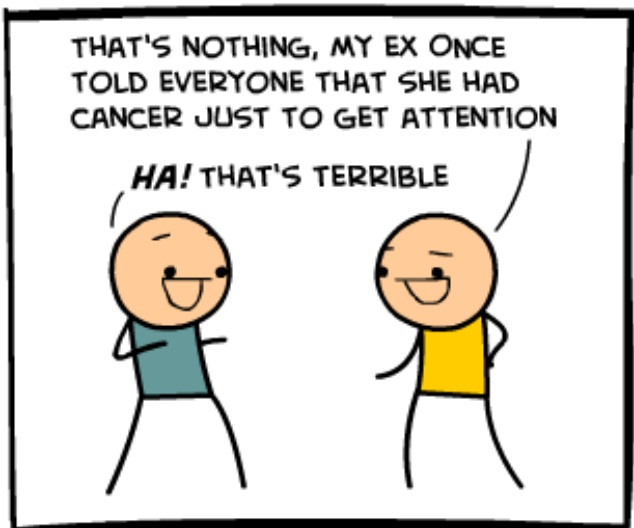

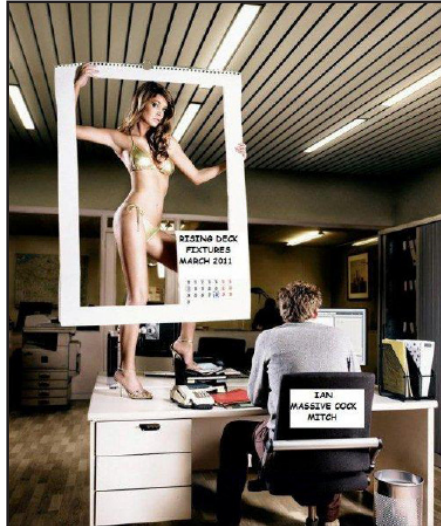
Week 8: Home to All Whites

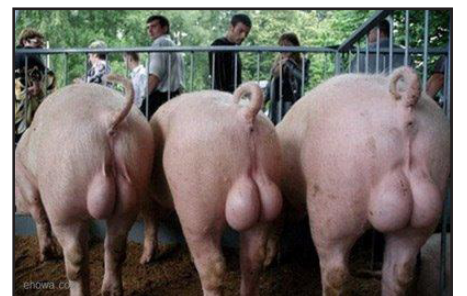
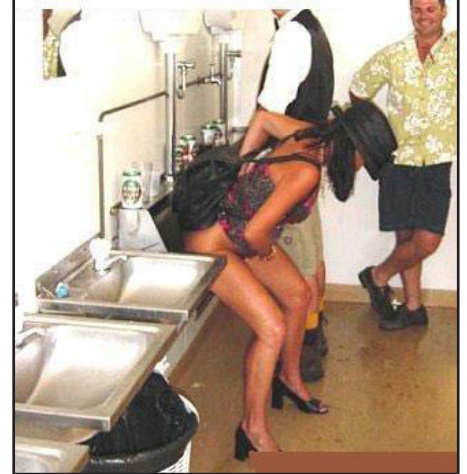
